

Aldi Scottish Sport Fund: FAQs

Q. How do I apply?

A. Just fill out an application form on www.aldi.co.uk/scottishsportfund and make sure to submit it before the deadline for your region.

Q. What's the deadline for applying?

A. Each region has a different deadline. You can find deadline details here <u>www.aldi.co.uk/scottishsportfund</u>

Q. It doesn't look like the Sport Fund is available in my area. Why is this?

A. The Aldi Scottish Sport Fund is open in regions where there is currently an Aldi store in Scotland.

Q. My organisation operates across multiple regions. Which deadline applies to me?

A. If you have a club that operates across different areas, make that clear on your entry form and submit your application ahead of the deadline date for any of the regions in which you operate.

Q. How will I know if my application has been successful?

A. We'll contact each applicant using the email address provided on their entry form.

Q. My club needs more than £2500. Can I apply for more funding?

A. We want to help as many clubs as we can so to make this possible we have set a tiered structure of donations for successful clubs. There are three funding packages available per region: $1 \times £2500$, $2 \times £1000$, and $1 \times £500$.

Q. Why does my club have to meet your eligibility requirements to apply?

A. Aldi's goal is to increase the positive impact we have on local communities and we want to help as many sports clubs as possible. However, to ensure that our charitable donations go to legitimate organisations we can only accept applications from organisations based in Scotland that meet one or more of the following criteria (please see our full T&Cs for more information):

- a local, community focused club with Sport at the heart of what you do
- a registered community amateur sports club (CASC)
- a school or educational organisation
- a religious organisation
- a Scout or Guide group
- a charitable service fund of the Armed Forces

• a Community Interest Company registered with The Office of the Regulator of Community Interest Companies

Exclusions

- Organisations outside Scotland
- Political parties
- Individual Sponsorship
- Travel and Accommodation requests
- Exclusive membership organisations
- University Sports Clubs

Q: I'm not a registered charity. Can I apply?

A: Yes. Applications are open to organisations in Scotland that meet one or more of the following criteria:

- a local, community focused club with Sport at the heart of what you do
- a registered community amateur sports club (CASC)
- a school or educational organisation
- a religious organisation
- a Scout or Guide group
- a charitable service fund of the Armed Forces
- a Community Interest Company registered with The Office of the Regulator of Community Interest Companies

The following exclusions apply:

- Organisations outside Scotland
- Political parties
- Individual Sponsorship
- Travel and Accommodation requests
- Exclusive membership organisations
- University Sports Clubs
