







Each time you complete a round, place a stitch marker (you can use a contrasting coloured thread) in the last stitch made. This marks where to end that round.

STITCH GUIDE

PATTERN

HEAD

Using white yarn.

Round 1: ch 1, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: [dc in next 2dc, inc] 6 times [24]

Round 5: [dc in next 3dc, inc] 6 times [30]

Round 6: [dc in next 4dc, inc] 6 times [36]

Round 7: 8dc, inc, 3dc, inc x 2, 3dc, inc, 8dc, inc, 3dc, inc x 2, 3dc, inc [44]

Round 8: inc, 7dc, inc, 6dc, inc, 6dc, inc, 7dc, inc, 6dc, inc, 6dc [50]

Rounds 9-10: dc in each st [50]

Round II: (inc. 9dc) 5 times [55]

Rounds 12-13: dc in each st [55]

Round 14: (inc. 10dc) 5 times [60]

Rounds 15-18: dc in each st [60]

Round 19: dc in each st [60]

Round 20: (dec. 10dc) 5 times [55]

Rounds 21-22: dc in each st [55]

Round 23: (dec. 9dc) 5 times [50]

Rounds 24-25: dc in each st [50]

Round 26: dec. 7dc, dec. 6dc, dec. 6dc, dec. 7dc, dec. 6dc, dec. 6dc [44]

Round 27: 8dc, dec. 3dc, dec x 2, 3dc, dec. 8dc, dec. 3dc, dec x 2,

3dc. dec [36]

Round 28: [dc in next 4dc, dec] 6 times [30]

Round 29: [dc in next 3dc, dec] 6 times [24]

Stuff. Continue stuffing as you go.

Round 30: [dc in next 2dc, dec] 6 times [18]

Round 31: [dc in next dc, dec] 6 times [12]

Round 32: dec 6 times [6]

Finish off.

BODY

Using white yarn.

Round 1: ch 1, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: [dc in next 2dc, inc] 6 times [24]

Round 5: [dc in next 3dc, inc] 6 times [30]

Round 6: [dc in next 4dc, inc] 6 times [36]

Round 7: [dc in next 5dc, inc] 6 times [42]

Round 8: [dc in next 6dc, inc] 6 times [48]

Rounds 9-20: dc in each st [48]

Round 21: [dc in next 6dc, dec] 6 times [42]

Rounds 22-24: dc in each st [42]

Round 25: [dc in next 5dc, dec] 6 times [36]

Rounds 26-27: dc in each st [36]

Round 28: [dc in next 4dc, dec] 6 times [30]

Rounds 29-30: dc in each st [30]

Round 31: [dc in next 3dc. dec] 6 times [24]

Rounds 32-33: dc in each st [24]

Round 34: [dc in next 2dc, dec] 6 times [18]

Rounds 35-36: dc in each st [18]

Finish off.

Stuff and attach to head.

ARMS (MAKE 2)

Using beige yarn.

Round 1: ch 1, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: dc in each st [18]

Change to white yarn

Rounds 5-8: dc in each st [18]

Round 9: (dec, 4dc) 3 times [15]

Rounds 10-11: dc in each st [15]

Round 12: (dec. 3dc) 3 times [12]

Rounds 13-20: dc in each st [12]

Finish off.

Stuff and attach to body.

LEGS (MAKE 2)

Using beige yarn

Round I: ch I, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc, dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: [dc in next 2dc, inc] 6 times [24]

Rounds 5-8: dc in each st [24]

Round 9: [dc in next 2dc, dec] 6 times [18]

Rounds 10-15: dc in each st [18]

Round 16: [dc in next dc, dec] 6 times [12]

Rounds 17-20: dc in each st [12]

Finish off. Stuff and attach to body.

EARS (MAKE 2)

Using white yarn

Round 1: ch 1, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: dc in each st [6]

Round 3: [inc. Idc] 3 times [9]

Rounds 4-5: dc in each st [9]

Round 6: [inc .2dc] 3 times [12]

Round 7: dc in each st [12]

Round 8: [inc, 3dc] 3 times [15]

Rounds 9-15: dc in each st [15]

Round 16: [dec, 3dc] 3 times [12]

Finish off. Sew together.

BANDANA

Using yellow yarn.

Row 1: 2ch, 1dc turn [2]

Row 2: Ich, inc, Idc turn [3]

Row 3: 1ch, inc, 2dc turn [4]

Row 4: 1ch, inc, 3dc turn [5]

Row 5: Ich, inc, 4dc turn [6]

Row 6: Ich, inc, 5dc turn [7]

change to brown yarn

Row 7: Ich, inc. 6dc turn [8]

Row 8: Ich, inc, 7dc turn [9]

Row 9: 1ch, inc, 8dc turn [10]

Row 10: 1ch,inc, 9dc turn [11] change to blue yarn

Row II: 1ch. inc. 10dc turn [12]

Row 12: Ich, inc, Ildc turn [13]

Row 13: 1ch,inc, 12dc turn [14]

chl2, starting from second chain from hook, dcll

Finish off. Sew bandana round neck.

TAIL

Using white yarn.

Round I: ch I, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4-5: dc in each st [18]

Round 6: [dc in next ldc, dec] 6 times [12]

Rounds 7-8: dc in each st [12]

Round 9: dec 6 times [6]

Finish off.

SNOUT

Using beige yarn.

Round I: ch I, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: [dc in next 2dc, inc] 6 times [24]

Round 5: [dc in next 3dc, inc] 6 times [30] Round 6: dc in each st [30]

Finish off.

Embroider eyes and mouth.

Cut lengths of yarn and attach to top of head and fray yarn to make hair fluffy.
