

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: dc in each st [18]

Change to grey yarn

Rounds 5-8: dc in each st [18]

Round 9: (dec, 4dc) 3 times [15]

Rounds 10-11: dc in each st [15]

Round 12: (dec. 3dc) 3 times (12) Rounds 13-20: dc in each st (12)

Finish off.

Stuff and attach to body.

## LEGS (MAKE 2)

Using black yarn

Round I: ch I, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc, dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: [dc in next 2dc, inc] 6 times [24]

Rounds 5-8: dc in each st [24]

Round 9: [dc in next 2dc, dec] 6 times [18]

Rounds 10-15: dc in each st [18]

Round 16: [dc in next dc, dec] 6 times [12]

Rounds 17-20: dc in each st [12]

Finish off.

Stuff and attach to body.

#### **TAIL**

Using black yarn

Round I: ch I, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Rounds 2-3: dc in each st [6] Round 4: inc 6 times [12]

Grey yarn

Rounds 5-7: dc in each st [12]

Round 8: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Change to black yarn.

Rounds 9-12: dc in each st [18]

Change to grey yarn.

Rounds 13-15: dc in each st [18]

Round 16: [dec. dc in next dc] 6 times [12]

Change to black yarn.

Rounds 17-19: dc in each st [12]

Round 20: [dec, 2dc] 3 times [9]

Finish off.

Stuff and attach to body.

#### EARS (MAKE 2)

Using grey yarn

Round | ch |, 6 dc in ring [6].

Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: dc in each st [6]

Round 3: [inc, Idc] 3 times [9]

Round 4: dc in each st [9]

Round 5: [inc. 2dc] 3 times [12]

Round 6: dc in each st [12]

Round 7: linc, 3dcl 3 times [15]

Round 8: [inc. 4dc] 3 times [18]

Rounds 9-10: dc in each st [18]

Finish off.

Using black yarn.

ch5, starting in second ch from hook 5dc, turn

1ch, 5dq, turn

1ch, 4dc, turn

1ch. 3dq, turn

Ich, 2dc.

Finish off.

Sew to head.

## SNOUT

Using white yarn

Round 1. ch 1, 6 dc in ring [6]. Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: 3dc in next st, inc x 4, 3dc in next st [14]

Round 3: 2dc (inc. Idc.) 2 times, 2dc, inc. Idc, inc., 3dc [18]

Round 4: 2dc. inc. 4dc. dec x 2. 4dc. inc. 2dc [18]

Round 5: 3dc, inc, 10dc, inc, 3dc [20]

Round 6: inc x 4, 12dc, inc x 4 [28]

Round 7: dc in each st [28] Finish off.

Stuff and attach to head.

## OUTERIEYE (MAKE 2)

Using white yarn

Round I<sub>i</sub> ch I, 6 dc in ring [6]. Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: [dc in next 2dc, inc] 6 times [24]

Round 5: [2dc, inc] 3 times, Idc, 6htr, Idc, [inc, 2dc] 2 times, inc [30]

Round d: 12dc, [2htr in next st] 2 times, [2tr in next st] 3 times, [2htr in next st]

2 times, 12dc [38]

Finish off.

### EYE COLOUR (MAKE 2)

Using black yarn

Round I<sub>I</sub> ch I, 6 dc in ring [6]. Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Round 3: [inc. dc in next dc] 6 times [18]

Round 4: [dc in next 2dc, inc] 6 times [24]

#### EYE CENTRE (MAKE 2)

Using white yarn

Round I ch I. 6 dc in ring [6]. Do not join, work in continuous rounds.

Round 2: inc 6 times [12]

Stitch eye pieces on top of each other and embroider black pupil. Embroider nose and mouth.

## SCARF

Using orange yarn

chain 50, starting in second ch from hook dc to end.

Turn work 2 more rows.

Finish off.

Make 2 small pom poms in green yarn and sew to ends of scarf.
