## Who is the Rise with ALDI Bread Competition open to?

The Rise with ALDI Bread Competition is open to residents of the Republic of Ireland. To compete, you must be over 18 years on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2024. Directors, management, and employees (and the immediate families of directors, management, and employees) of ALDI are ineligible to enter.

#### I'm a professional chef/baker. Can I enter the competition?

Unfortunately, professional chefs and bakers are excluded from competing in Rise with ALDI Bread Competition.

# I'm a bread supplier. Can I enter the competition?

Suppliers are excluded from competing in Rise with ALDI Bread Competition.

Drop your home-baked bread to the nearest location to you from the below list of dates and locations:

What do I do when I go to the drop off point?

Drop your bread to the collection point at the entrance to the ALDI Store/ Office. Please ensure your bread is clearly labelled with your name, address, email address and contact number. Participants can

nominate a person of their choice to drop their baked bread to a collection point.

How many breads can I submit?

Each participant may only submit one bread. Please note that a 2lb loaf tin or a cob shaped tin must

be used to bake your bread. Any bread that is not in this 2lb loaf tin or cob shaped tin will not be

eligible. Please present your bread unsliced to ensure freshness for judges. Please note, your tin will

not be returned.

How will I find out if I am successful?

Winning entrants will be contacted by the 3<sup>rd</sup> of July 2024. Unfortunately, no feedback will be provided

to unsuccessful entries. Queries can be directed to <u>risewithaldi@aldi.ie</u>.

What happens if I am successful?

The top three Bread bakers, as determined by the judges, will go through to the finals where they will

bake their Bread live in front of the judges at Airfield Estate in September 2024. The overall winner's

bread will be stocked in all ALDI stores nationwide from January 2025.

What are the prizes?

1st prize: €15,000, plus the winner's bread will be stocked in all ALDI stores nationwide.

2nd prize: €1,000 ALDI shopping vouchers

3rd prize: €500 ALDI shopping vouchers

What type of bread can I make?

Participants can bake a bread of their choice from the following list:

- White Bread
- Soda bread
- Ciabatta
- Rye Bread
- Sourdough

- 2. Nuts (Any type of nuts)
